OVERVIEW

Let's meet in Denver for an evening amid the incredible craft beer scene with welcome dinner at a local speakeasy. Then we'll board Amtrak's California Zephyr for a 33-hour train ride across the Rockies to San Francisco in First Class sleeper accommodations. Experienced travelers say the Amtrak California Zephyr is one of the most beautiful train trips in all of North America. As you climb through the heart of the Rockies, and further west through the snow-capped Sierra Nevada's, you'll understand why. The Zephyr runs between Chicago and San Francisco, but we'll be onboard through the most scenic part, starting in Denver! We'll have private rooms with sleeping berths, and access to bathroom with showers in our car or you can upgrade to a private bath in your room. You can roam around the Zephyr, enjoying the views of the majestic Rockies and mountain ranges in the observation deck, or go to the lounges to enjoy beverages. All meals will be provided on the Zephyr with first class service! On the way we'll have tastings and group lessons on the art of wine led by our guide, a Level 1 Sommelier; an enthusiastic wine expert with mighty plans for us in Napa Valley where we'll have many tastings.

Once we arrive in San Francisco, we'll spend 2 nights in the city exploring this magnificent city's cultural highlights with our private van and driver. Lots of options! Then on to Napa, with a two-night stay in the Calistoga Hot Springs area, for a comfortable, welcoming, home base with everything Napa Valley has to offer. We're going in October during Crush Season so we can experience the region during harvest and help process the grapes by stomping them. I Love Lucy style!

ITINERARY

Monday Day 1:



Today is the arrival day into
Denver. We'll begin activities in the late
afternoon, after checking into our hotel.
We'll head off to two very cool
neighborhoods; the LoDo and RiNo
districts. There are all sorts of eclectic
shops, cafes, and historic buildings to
explore. We'll have an included welcome
dinner at one of the cool speakeasies in
one of these hip areas, and sample some
craft beers Denver is famous for.

Tuesday Day 2:

Today (breakfast included at hotel), bright and early, 8 a.m. - We board the California Zephyr for our 33-hour train ride. But don't worry, we'll be entertained with majestic views for much of the morning and afternoon. We'll get first class service with all meals provided, and we have access to lounges for drinks anytime we want.

Our rooms contain sleeping berths, and the sleeping cars have shared bathrooms with showers.





Wednesday Day 3:

We'll continue our train ride through the beautiful western USA until late afternoon, with special entertainment just for our group. We'll be presented with lessons from our own sommelier on wine tasting and interesting history on Napa Valley. Be prepared to taste and learn something new.







Our Zephyr train ride ends at 4 p.m. in Emeryville, CA, so we'll take transportation to our San Francisco accommodations – the Hotel Zephyr!!!, for 2 nights. That evening we'll go to Fisherman's Wharf to walk along the piers and eat some great seafood in a restaurant on the wharf. We'll also visit Ghirardelli Square where the U.S. oldest, continuously-operating chocolate producer was incorporated in 1852.

Thursday Day 4:



This morning, we head out to visit Alcatraz Island for a tour or you can venture over to Sausalito to explore their vibe and Art Galleries. Once we ferry back, you'll have some free time, maybe catch a trolley car and visit Lombard Street on your own and have lunch. That evening we have a private walking tour of Chinatown and Little Italy with a local guide. Dinner will take place during the tour.

We have a private driver and van lined up for these next two days as we venture out of San Francisco. We'll stop at the Golden Gate Bridge to see the views and take obligatory pictures, then drive into the magnificent Muir Woods, admire the redwoods and where we can do an easy hike for about an hour.







Its back to the van, Lunch at Andy's Local Market, a fantastic deli, then on to our first tasting. (vineyard itinerary to be detailed later)

In the evening we'll enjoy a hilarious and famous tradition! A Grape Stomp and **dinner (included)** at the vineyard, then transfer to Calistoga's Upvalley Inn & Hot Springs for 2 nights.

Saturday Day 6:

Breakfast at a local restaurant. We'll continue with more exclusive wine tours and tastings, in unique and luxury wineries. We'll learn about the history of wine making in the area, and visit some historic places.







4 p.m. - Choose between returning to the hotel for a spa evening (cost varies) or and early dinner at the Michelin rated French Laundry (time depends on reservation) \$\$\$\$\$\$

Sunday Day 7:

Breakfast at a local restaurant, Take an optional leisurely morning bicycle (or e-bike) ride with our guide. Lunch at a local farm-to-table restaurant or vineyard. Two more wine tasting tours. Drive to San Fransisco and settle in at the Airport Hotel for the night. We'll have our **farewell dinner** (included) tonight included in the tour, at a very nice restaurant, to cap off our wonderful week.

Monday Day 8:

After breakfast we check out, then go to the San Francisco airport to fly home.

Tuesday Day 9:

Breakfast included at the hotel. Drive toward Santa Barbara, stopping at the Bixby Bridge for the view. Lunch at Nepenthe in Big Sur, stop for a walk at the Julie Pfeifer Burns State Park, admission included. Arrive in Santa Barbara and check into the Inn. Free time before dinner on the wharf. Stay at the Chumash Casino Resort.
