
Venice Italy

MONDAY, MARCH 10: FULL DAY EXCURSION TO TRENTO

History, culture and nature: these are the three pillars that form the foundation of Trento: a city with about 117,000 inhabitants and the capital city of Trentino-Alto Adige. The **history** is that of the prince bishops, for centuries unrivalled signori of this flourishing city, a meeting point between the Mediterranean and continental worlds, culture is alive thanks to the prestigious University, and to many other museums and historical sites. In Trento you will see **Piazza Duomo** and stop under the Fountain of Neptune for a photo of the impressive Duomo [Cathedral] of Trento, with the mountains in the background. On its left hand side, with castellated walls and the high Torre Civica, lies Palazzo Pretorio, home of the Diocesan Museum of Trento, then you can walk around the fountain to admire the beautiful **Renaissance frescoes** on the Cazuffi Rella homes, focused on the themes of Justice and Luck.

After sipping a coffee at one of the bars overlooking the piazza, you can decide whether to visit the **Duomo** or to walk along **Via Belenzani**, to admire the frescoes of Palazzo Alberti Colico, Palazzo Thun and Palazzo Geremia.

In Bolzano be enchanted by the **different architectural styles** that are colourful and soft and, as soon as you turn the corner, become imposing and square. Stroll along the acardes, the commercial heart of the old town over 300 metres long, listening to the mix of languages that characterise the city and taste the perfect **combination of Tyrolean cuisine and Mediterranean flavours** in the many restaurants in the city streets.

FULL DAY EXCURSION TO INNSBRUCK







Taking pride of place in the heart of the Tyrol region, Innsbruck is an Austrian gem that is perfect for travellers who love to explore smaller cities while being surrounded by jawdropping sights of the Alps mountain range. It's got the charming architecture the region is known for and plenty of nature just a stone's throw from the city centre.

The Innsbruck sightseeing list isn't super extensive, but this is a city of quality over quantity. With just one day in Innsbruck, you'll be able to see a lot as you wander around the compact city, but here are a few of the top things to do in Innsbruck, and sights you want to make sure you don't miss, such as the Golden Roof, the Old town, and the city tower.

Included is also the visit of Museum Swaroski: Swarovski Crystal Worlds was opened in 1995 to mark the centennial anniversary of the company's founding. Tour around the Sella group:

A day on the **Sellaronda is truly one of the highlights of a skiing holiday in the Dolomites**. On the famous ski circuit in South Tyrol (Italy), you can circle the <u>Sella group</u> on an impressive day tour. The ski circuit stretches over a length of about 40 kilometres, 24 kilometres of which are covered by lifts that **only require a single ski pass** to use: the <u>Dolomiti Superski ski</u> <u>pass</u>.

There are several entry points to the Sellaronda, which runs across four Do-

lomite passes and past five beautiful villages. On your way, which takes

you over Passo Campolongo, Passo Pordoi, Passo Sella and Passo Gar-

dena, you won't need to remove your skis even once. The order in which you

cross these passes and through the villages of Arabba, Canazei, Selva,

Corvara and Colfosco is up to you.

The Sellaronda is suitable for skiers with a medium to high level of fit-

ness. Starting before 10 am is highly recommended so that you can

reach the lift that takes you back to the starting point in time. The ski tour takes about six hours in total.

The **Sellaronda ski area** is part of the <u>Dolomiti Superski</u> ski association and runs **around the Sella group** in the Dolomites in South Tyrol - a plateau-shaped mountain group from which four magnificent valleys extend. More than 500 kilometres of slopes and over 200 lifts form the ideal conditions for winter sports in the ski area. Even intermediate skiers can master the Sellaronda in one day. **Tip:** If you are looking for a greater challenge, it is recommended that you plan a detour to the <u>Saslong Ski World Cup</u> slope in <u>S. Cristina</u> in Val Gardena.

The Sellaronda can be skied in two directions. The <u>orange signs</u> lead you clockwise around the Sella group. From the <u>Val Gardena ski area</u>, you can start with the Dantercepies lift (#30). The first few kilometres of slopes of this wonderful skiing adventure start at the Passo Gardena.

The green signs guide you in a counter-clockwise direction. From Val Gardena, you enter the green Sella circuit via the Plan de Gralba ski area. Find out for yourself which direction you prefer. As some lifts may be closed in bad weather, it is advisable to check the current opening times

Endless distance & cross-country trails!

Val Gardena is a special treat for cross-country skiers: the Monte Pana in S. Cristina, the Vallunga in Selva Gardena and the Alpe di Siusi offer a unique, fantastic panorama. The valley, which offers more than 133 km of well-prepared crosscountry ski runs in all degrees of difficulty, can be described as the eldorado for cross-country skiers. Crystal-clear air, in snow covered meadows and forests, the impressive Dolomite mountains: come and discover a little cross-country paradise!
